

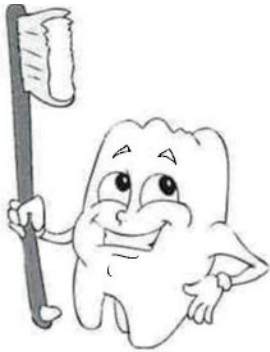

a program of complimentary sealant placement for children in the second grade.

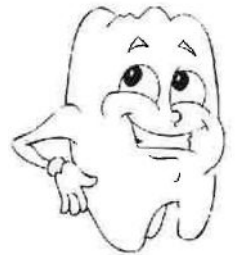
